On August 11, 2015, your client, Jose Susumo Azano Matsura, was notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that he violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30121(a)(1), 30122 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act") and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.20(b)-(c), (f) and 110.4(b)(i). On July 17, 2018, the Commission found that your client's violations of the Act were knowing and willful,

After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on June 12, 2019, to take no further action as to your client, and closed the file in this matter.
