On September 21, 2017, the Office of General Counsel mailed to you a brief ("General Counsel's Brief") setting forth the factual and legal basis upon which the Office of General Counsel was prepared to recommend that the Commission find probable cause to believe that your client, Government Integrity, LLC, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.4(b)(1)(i). Pursuant to the Commission's *Agency Procedure Following the Submission of Probable Cause Briefs by the Office of General Counsel*, 76 Fed. 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23 On September 21, 2017, the Office of the General Counsel ("OGC") notified  
24 Government Integrity, LLC ("GI LLC") that it was prepared to recommend that the Commission  
25 find probable cause to believe that GI LLC knowingly and willfully violated  
26 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.4(b)(1)(i) by making a contribution in the name of  
27 another.<sup>1</sup> OGC's notification included a General Counsel's Brief setting forth the factual and  
28 legal basis for the recommendation. On October 6, 2017, GI LLC submitted a reply brief.

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30 Pursuant to the Agency Procedure Following the Submission of Probable Cause Briefs by  
31 the Office of General Counsel, 76 Fed. Reg. 63,570 (Oct. 13, 2011), OGC is hereby notifying the  
32 Commission that it intends to proceed with the recommendation to find probable cause to believe  
33 that GI LLC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.4(b)(1)(i) based on the factual and  
34 legal analysis set forth in the General Counsel's Brief.
