22	RE:	Proposed Conciliation Agreement for Probable Cause Conciliation

Attached is a proposed conciliation agreement for probable cause conciliation with New Day for America and J. Matthew Yuskewich in his official capacity as treasurer ("New Day"). The proposed agreement is for the Commission's consideration along with the Office of General Counsel's Notice to the Commission Following the Submission of Probable Cause Brief in MURs 6955 and 6983 ("OGC Notice"), which is being submitted to the Commission

29 simultaneously with this Memorandum.

30 The OGC Notice informs the Commission and the Respondents that this Office intends to proceed with the recommendation that the Commission find probable cause to believe that New 31 Day: (1) violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116 and 30118(a) in connection with making impermissible 32 and excessive contributions for John R. Kasich's testing-the-waters activities prior to registering 33 with the Commission as an independent expenditure-only political committee ("IEOPC"); and 34 (2) violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116 and 30118(a) by making prohibited and excessive in-kind 35 contributions to Kasich for America and J. Matthew Yuskewich in his official capacity as 36 37 treasurer ("KFA") in the form of coordinated communications.
