




5. Find no reason to believe that Zeldin for Senate violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30103 and 30104 by failing to register and report as a federal political committee.
6. Find no reason to believe that Islip Town Conservative Executive Committee, Suffolk Conservative Chairman's Club, Friends of Senft, New York State Conservative Party, Smithtown Conservatives for Victory, Smithtown Women's Republican Club, Smithtown Republican Victory Fund, Babylon Conservative Committee, Riverhead Republican Committee, Committee to Elect a Republican Majority, Queens County Conservative Party, or New York Republican State Committee violated the Act.
7. Close the file as to Zeldin for Congress and Nancy Marks in her official capacity as treasurer, Islip Town Conservative Executive Committee, Suffolk Conservative Chairman's Club, Friends of Senft, New York State Conservative Party, Smithtown Conservatives for Victory, Smithtown Women's Republican Club, Smithtown Republican Victory Fund, Babylon Conservative Committee, Riverhead Republican Committee, Committee to Elect a Republican Majority, Queens County Conservative Party, and New York Republican State Committee.
8. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis sample for state and local party committees, as well as the Factual and Legal Analyses for Zeldin for Senate and Lee Zeldin, and Zeldin for Congress, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated September 9, 2016, subject to the edits last circulated by the Office of General Counsel on March 23, 2017 at 9:50 a.m.
9. Enter into conciliation with Lee Zeldin and Zeldin for Senate prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
10. Approve the Conciliation Agreement as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated September 9, 2016, subject to the edits last circulated by Commissioner Goodman's office on March 20, 2017 at 9:43 a.m.
11. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Goodman, Hunter, Petersen, Walther and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.
