## I. INTRODUCTION

On July 31, 2018, the Commission found reason to believe that Ted Cruz for Senate and Bradley S. Knippa in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(E) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(d)(4) by misreporting loans totaling \$1,064,000 when it failed to properly disclose the source of the loans. The Commission authorized pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement with an opening settlement offer of .${ }^{1}$
