**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission agreeing to hold the proceedings in this matter in abeyance during the pendency of a related criminal matter, Respondents Duncan D. Hunter for Congress and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer hereby consent to extend the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement suit that the Commission might institute pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) until the conclusion by verdict, guilty plea, or dismissal of the criminal case entitled *United States v. Duncan D. Hunter and Margaret E. Hunter*, 3:18-cr-03677 (S.D. Cal.).

This agreement thereby extends the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 and/or any other statutes of limitations or repose that may be applicable from the date of this Consent until the criminal case is concluded as described above. This Consent supplements the Consent previously agreed to by Respondents on May 24, 2018.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil enforcement suit without the written consent of Respondent.
