On April 22, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, RevUp Software, Inc. (“RevUp”), that it found reason to believe that RevUp violated 52 U.S.C. § 30111(a)(4) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.15(a) of the Commission regulations. On June 10, 2019, you submitted a response to the Commission’s reason to believe findings on your client’s behalf. On October 22, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
