On May 9, 2017, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated May 12, 2016, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find no reason to believe Arizona Grassroots Action PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30120(a) or 30104(b). Accordingly, on May 9, 2017, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
