On May 20, 2016, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Arizona Grassroots Action PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On May 9, 2017, the Commission considered the Complaint, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find no reason to believe that Arizona Grassroots Action PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30120(a) or 30104(b). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
