Dear Mr. Jordan:

I am writing in response to a letter my office received on July 5, 2016 regarding the above referenced matter. The complaint, drafted by Mr. Seth Gunning, (the "Complaint") alleges that:

"as much as 51% (\$102,000), of the PAC's total expenditures has likely been funnelled [sic] to just three individuals involved in the PAC's administration: CEO Kyle Prall, of Austin, Texas, Attorney Joseph Centrich, also of Austin, Texas, and online marketer Johan Garcia, of Miami/Ft. Lauderdale, Florida."

Complaint, p.6 (emphasis added). The allegations made against me are completely false.

Neither I nor my firm was ever involved in the establishment or management of the PAC, and to-date have only been hired by Kyle Prall to represent that PAC on a single issue (MUR 7011), for which I received payment \$1,022.25. Prior to that representation, I had been hired by clients to set up the LLCs mentioned in the Complaint. I have no financial or ownership interest in any of these companies, nor do I have any involvement in their management.
