General Counsel's Report

Background

On August 30, 1978, respondent was referred to the Office of General Counsel as a non-filer in regard to his candidacy for the House of Representatives from the 10th Congressional District in Indiana in the primary election held on May 2, 1978. The respondent was previously before the Commission as a non-filer in regard to this candidacy in MUR 566. In regard to the present MUR, the respondent failed to amend his Statement of Candidate to designate a principal campaign committee and, also, failed to have a Statement of Organization filed for such a committee. The Commission notified respondent to that effect in a letter dated May 19, 1978. The Commission found reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe that the respondent had violated 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.11. Letters notifying the respondent of the Commission's findings were mailed to him by certified mail on June 30, 1978, and July 20, 1978, respectively. There has been no response from the respondent.

The charges in the present MUR overlap those in 566 where the Commission found reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe that the respondent had violated 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1) by his failure to file a Statement of Candidate and to designate a Principal Campaign Committee. Subsequent to the Commission's finding the respondent filed a Statement of Candidate. In a telephone conversation he told a member of the General Counsel's staff that he had no receipts or expenses in regard to his candidacy. On the basis of these facts the Office of General Counsel recommended that no further action be taken in regard to this respondent and that the file be closed (see attached reports). On June 7, 1978, the Commission voted to approve the General Counsel's report and to close the file on MUR 566.

Analysis

The issue and facts before the Commission in the present MUR are essentially the same as those before the Commission at the time MUR 566 was closed.

Recommendation

In view of the above facts we recommend that the Commission take no further action with regard to this matter and close the file.

Background

On April 17, 1978, the Disclosure Division referred to the Office of General Counsel the names of three candidates for the House of Representatives who had registered with the Indiana State Board of Elections but had each failed to file a Statement of Candidate and designate a Principal Campaign Committee. The candidates registered with the Indiana State Board of Elections on March 3, 1978, and their Statements of Candidate and Designations of Principal Campaign Committees were due on April 2, 1978. For each of the three candidates, the Commission found reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe that 2 U.S.C. §432(e)(1) had been violated. Each respondent was notified of the Commission's findings. Reason to Believe letters were mailed to the respondents by certified mail on April 4, 1978; Reasonable Cause to Believe letters were mailed to the respondents by certified mail on April 13, 1978.

Analysis

Damian J. Santay MUR 566a

On April 10, 1978, the respondent Damian J. Santay called Beverly White in the Disclosure Division for clarification of the reporting requirements. Subsequently, the respondent filed his Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2). His Statement of Organization (FEC Form 1) has not been received yet, but the respondent indicated in his conversation with Ms. White that he would file it even though he had no intentions of raising or spending any money. Ms. White had indicated to the respondent that his Statement of Organization was due 10 days after his Statement of Candidate was filed, so the Statement of Organization can be expected any day now.

John C. Salomone MUR 566b

Subsequent to the referral by the Disclosure Division, the respondent John C. Salomone filed a Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2) and a Statement of Organization (FEC Form 1) for his principal campaign committee bringing him in compliance with the reporting provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.

Randall Harmon MUR 566c

On April 23, 1973, the Disclosure Division received a copy of the Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2) from

respondent Randall Harmon. The day before Anne Cauman of the Office of General Counsel called the respondent who did not understand that he needed to file a Statement of Organization. The respondent indicated that he is 75 years old and has run for Congress regularly since 1943; he has never raised or spent money for any of his previous campaigns and has no intentions of doing so now. While he is willing to comply with the Regulations he expressed considerable concern about finding another person to serve on his principal campaign committee. The respondent seemed somewhat vague and confused throughout the lengthy conversation and did not clearly understand what was required despite extensive efforts to explain it to him.

Recommendation

In view of the above facts, we recommend that the Commission take no further action with regard to these respondents and that the file be closed.

General Counsel's Report

Background

The respondent was a candidate for the House of Representatives from the 10th Congressional District in Indiana who failed to file a Statement of Candidate and designate a Principal Campaign Committee. The Commission found reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe that the respondent had violated 2 U.S.C. §432(e)(1). Letters notifying the respondent of the Commission's findings were mailed to him by certified mail on April 4, 1978, and April 13, 1978, respectively.

Subsequently we received a Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2) from the respondent, and a member of the General Counsel's staff had a telephone conversation with him in which he indicated he had no receipts or expenses for his campaign.

On the basis of this information the General Counsel's office recommended closing the file in regard to this respondent. On May 3, 1978, the Commission voted by 5-0 to close the file on this respondent if he did not turn

out to be the winner of the primary election held on Tuesday, May 2, 1978.

Analysis

The Secretary of State of Indiana sent us the primary results for the 10th Congressional District after they were officially certified on May 17, 1978 (see attached). The respondent received 1,758 votes, the lowest number of votes for any Democratic candidate in the 10th Congressional District, losing the election.

Recommendation

In view of the above facts we recommend that the Commission take no further action with regard to this respondent and that the file be closed.

This designation must be made even if you do not intend to use a committee to receive ^{sp. x} or expend funds. The principal campaign committee must also register and file reports (FEC Regulations Sec. 102.11(a)). The Statement of Organization must be filed within ten days after its designation by the candidate (FEC Regulations Sec. 102.1(a)).

Also, 2 U.S.C. 437b(a)(1) requires each candidate for Federal office to designate one or more national or State banks as a campaign depository. Section 102.3(a) of the FEC Regulations requires all contributions received by a candidate and authorized committees to be deposited into a checking account at the designated depository. All campaign expenditures, except those made to one (1) person of \$100 or less from a petty cash fund (2 U.S.C. Sec 437(b)), must be made from the designated depository.

Finally, Section 101.3 of the FEC Regulations provides for a waiver of candidate reporting if all receipts and expenditures will be handled by an authorized committee. If you are entitled to this waiver, please request this option. If you will personally receive and expend funds and will file separate reports, this information must also be disclosed.
