The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in the complaint you submitted on behalf of your client, Tim Canova, dated August 10, 2016, and voted to dismiss the allegations as to all of the respondents pursuant to *Heckler v. Chaney*, 470 U.S. 821 (1985). Accordingly, on July 13, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).

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The Federal Election Campaign Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).
