On August 19, 2016, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Kay Brown and Kate Houghton, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the Complaint was attached to the notification letter.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by you, on July 13, 2021, the Commission voted to dismiss the allegations as to your clients pursuant to *Heckler v. Chaney*, 470 U.S. 871 (1985), and closed the file.
