On August 19, 2016, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Debbie Wasserman Schultz for Congress and Lawrence Wasserman in his official capacity as treasurer, Debbie Wasserman Schultz, Steven Paikowsky, David Beattie, Ryan Banfill, SKDKnickerbocker, Hilary Rosen, and Ed Peavy, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was attached to the notification letter.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by you, on July 13, 2021, the Commission voted to dismiss the allegations as to all your clients pursuant to *Heckler v. Chaney*, 470 U.S. 821 (1985). Accordingly, on July 13, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See *Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
