On August 19, 2016, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, the Democratic National Committee and Andrew Tobias in his official capacity as treasurer, Ali Khan, Garret Bonosky, Mark Paustenbach, Tracie Pough, Raul Alvillar, April Mellody, and Luis Miranda, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the Complaint was attached to the notification letter.

Upon further review of the allegations, and information submitted by you, on July 13, 2021, the Commission voted to dismiss the allegations as to all your clients pursuant to *Heckler v. Chaney*, 470 U.S. 871 (1985). Accordingly, on July 13, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
