Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation

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This matter was initiated by a sua sponte submission by the Michigan Democratic State Central Committee and Sandy O'Brien in her official capacity as treasurer ("MDP") to notify the Commission of potential violations arising out of bingo games that MDP operated to raise money for its federal account. On August 16, 2016, the Commission made reason to believe findings.² In addition, the Commission authorized pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement.³ Accordingly, the Office of General Counsel engaged in conciliation discussions with the Respondent; attached is a final negotiated agreement, signed by MDP's counsel, that would settle the violations in this matter. We recommend that the Commission accept the negotiated agreement and close the file in this matter.

On February 20, 2017, MDP amended its Statement of Organization to replace Ramesh Verma with Sandy O'Brien as treasurer.

The Commission found reason to believe that MDP violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(c)(1)-(3) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.9(a) by failing to keep an itemized record of contributions; violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(c)(5) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.9(b)(1) by failing to keep an itemized record of disbursements; violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.4(c)(3) by accepting anonymous cash contributions; violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(h)(1) and 11 C.F.R § 103.3 by failing to deposit receipts in an account at a designated depository; violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(h)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.10 by making prohibited cash disbursements; violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3 by understating total contributions and disbursements; and knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C., § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3 by reporting false contributions and refunds. 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We therefore recommend that the Commission accept the attached signed agreement and close the file in this matter.
