The Federal Election Commission previously notified your clients Midwest Region Laborers' Political League, Laborers' International Local #231, and Laborers' International Local #538 of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint and information supplied by your clients, the Commission, on January 28, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegations as they pertain to your clients, Midwest Region Laborers' Political League, Laborers' International Local #231, and Laborers' International Local #538. The Factual and Legal Analysis, which more fully explains the Commission's decision, is enclosed for your information.

You are advised that the confidentiality provisions of 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed.
