26 On December 12, 2017, the Commission found reason to believe that Precision
27 Pipeline, LLC and Jillian Preller violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(b)(3)(C) and 11 C.F.R.
28 § 114.5(a)(4) by soliciting contributions without informing an employee of his right to
29 refuse to contribute without any reprisal.¹ On January 28, 2021, the Commission
30 authorized pre-probable cause conciliation with Precision Pipeline, LLC and Jillian
31 Preller, and approved a conciliation agreement
