Dear Mr. Garrett:

On June 1, 2018, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Americans for Sensible Solutions PAC and you in your official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30124(b)(1) and 30104(a) and (b) and authorized an investigation into the matter. A copy of the Factual and Legal Analysis which more fully explains that basis for the Commission's decision was provided to you at that time. On March 25, 2020, you were notified that the Office of the General Counsel, based on information and documents obtained during the investigation, would be recommending that the Commission find reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30124(b)(1) in your personal capacity, and offered you the opportunity to respond. On February 9, 2021, the Commission was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that you, in your personal capacity, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30124(b)(1). After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission determined to dismiss this matter and closed the file on February 9, 2021. One or more Statements of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision to dismiss will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
