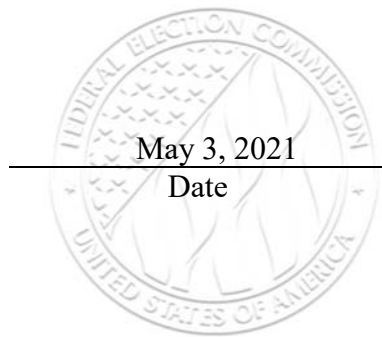
1. Find no reason to believe that Catherine Cortez Masto violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(f) or 30118(a).
