

**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO COMMENCE  
A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING**

**Respondents, Thornton Law Firm, Amy Thornton, Michael Thornton,  
Garrett Bradley, and David Strouss, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for  
any civil enforcement action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission  
might institute in connection with MUR 7183 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for an  
additional ninety (90) days.**

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for  
an additional ninety (90) calendar days, thereby totaling one-hundred and eighty (180)  
calendar days, which includes the first extension signed December 5, 2016, from the  
expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any  
other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law  
enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
