Dear Messrs. Jones and Bauer:

On November 7, 2016, the Federal Election Commission notified you both of a complaint alleging that Scott Jones and Sheriff Scott Jones for Congress and David Bauer in his official capacity as treasurer had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On October 11, 2017, the Commission considered the complaint, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find no reason to believe that Scott Jones or Sheriff Scott Jones for Congress violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
