Dear Sir or Madam:

We represent the Alaska Republican Party and Treasurer Julie Tisdale (hereinafter collectively referred to as “RPA”) in connection with the above-referenced matter. The complaint alleges the RPA: 1) failed to disclose coordinated party expenditures (“CPE”) made on behalf of the Republican candidate for the US Senate in 2016; 2) failed to correctly and adequately describe the purposes of transfers of funds from a candidate committee; and 3) made excessive CPE. The complaint claims that five mailers distributed by the party were problematic, i.e. an absentee ballot application distributed by the RPA and four mailers critical of Joe Miller, a Libertarian party candidate.

The complaint is completely without foundation and the commission should determine the complaint does not set forth any reason to believe that any violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 as amended has or will occur and close the matter.

1) The absentee ballot mailer was not a CPE and not subject to the CPE limit.

The absentee ballot mailer attached to the complaint was by law not a contribution to any of the candidates or campaigns referenced therein and was not an expenditure coordinated or otherwise. That mailer urged the recipients to obtain an absentee ballot so they could vote for four or five Republican candidates for four or five offices.¹ It mentioned four candidates by name and

¹ In Alaska in 2016, voters could vote for candidates for up to five positions: U. S. President, U.S. Senator., U. S. House, State Senate (in one-half the State Senate Districts), and State House. Alaska has 20 State Senators, but in 2016 only 10 of those seats were up for election. The copy of the absentee mailer included in the complaint was addressed to a voter in a state senate district where no state senate race occurred, i.e. only four races were on the ballot.

the seats they were running for and included a drawing or photo for each of the three federal candidates.

The mailer was consistent with 52 USC 30101(8)(B)(v) and 52 USC 30101(9)(B)(iv) and is neither a contribution to any candidate named or an expenditure by the party. It is not subject to the contribution limits for parties to candidates.

By law, the absentee voter mailer was not a contribution or a coordinated party expenditure. The allegation that it was somehow improper is groundless and should not be entertained by the commission.

2) The transfers or surplus funds by a candidate committee were consistent with the law and regulations.

This allegation pertains to transfers of surplus campaign funds from a candidate's committee to the State party committee. Pursuant to 52 USC §30114(a)(4) such transfers can be made by a candidate "without limitation" to a State political party. This issue was addressed in FEC Advisory Opinion 2004-22.² In that opinion, the FEC found that the legal provisions of the Act do not limit the ways a State political party can use the surplus funds received from a candidate's committee, nor do they restrict the amount transferred in any specific period of time. Notwithstanding the claimed "experience" of the complainant the transfer of excess campaign funds were consistent with the law and regulations.

The respective FEC reports of the RPA and the Murkowski campaign committee show that all transfers made by the committee were reported as received by the RPA within a few days of the transfers.

Therefore, the transfers from the candidate's committee to the RPA were properly made and reported and this allegation is without merit.

3) The four Miller mailers expenditures all occurred after the deadline for the pre-general election report and therefore were not required to be disclosed on that or prior reports.


As can be seen from the attached affidavit and records the four Miller mailers were mailed on October 21, 24, 26 and 31.³ Payments for the production of these mailers were made on or after October 24. Payments for the postage for these mailers were made by checks dated on or after October 26. Thus all of these expenditures were incurred after the closing date for the pre-general report (October 19, 2016) and are not required to be reported until the post general report deadline of December 8, 2016. Therefore, there is no basis to support a determination that these expenditures were not properly recorded and this allegation should be found to be without basis.

4) The cost of the four Miller mailers were CPE and did not exceed the CPE limit.

The attached affidavit and documents show that the total cost of the production and mailing of the four Miller mailers was \$56,111.60. By law, the allowable limit for coordinated party expenditures is \$96,100. Since the cost of the Miller mailings was substantially less than that limit, there is no basis for the allegation that the RPA violated the law by making excess CPEs. This allegation must be rejected.

.In summary, the complaint does not provide any evidence to support any reason to believe that any violations have occurred. The complaint is without merit and the matter should be closed.


Julie Tisdale being first duly sworn hereby states as follows:

- 1) I am the Treasurer of the Alaska Republican Party (“ARP”) and as such am the custodian of the financial records of the ARP. I have personal knowledge of the facts as stated herein.
- 2) In the 2016 General Election campaign in Alaska, the ARP engaged in a Coordinated Party Expenditure effort (“CPE”) on behalf of the ARP’s nominee for the United States Senate, Lisa Murkowski and her campaign committee Lisa Murkowksi for U. S. Senate.
- 3) That CPE effort involved the design, production and mailing of four mailers to a select groups of voters. The plan was that those mailers would be mailed to arrive in the two weeks prior to the election held on November 8, 2016.
- 4) The design production and creation of the mailing list for all mailers was done by a vendor named Service Business Printing.

- 5) Each of the mailers was mailed at the bulk mail facility at the U. S. Postal Service in Anchorage.
- 6) Attached are documents concerning the cost of production and mailing of each of the four flyers.
- 7) Exhibit 1 is correspondence and the invoice for the production of the first two mailers. As can be seen the cost of production of each was \$8,324.00. Exhibit 2 is a copy of the RPA check # 2834 for \$ 16,648.00 paying the production cost of those two mailings. Exhibit 3 is a copy of the paperwork from the postal service showing the cost of mailing those first two mailers. Exhibit 4 is a copy of the check # 2836 for \$11,407.80 paying for the postage for the first two mailers.
- 8) Exhibit 5 is a copy of the bill from Service Business Printing for the production of the second two mailers. Exhibit 6 is a copy of the RPA check #2843 paying that amount. Exhibit 7 is the paperwork from the postal service for the cost of mailing and Exhibit 8 is a copy of check #2838 paying for the postage for the third and final mailers.
- 9) As can be seen the total cost of the production and mailing of the four mailers was \$56,111.60.
- 10) The CPE limit for the ARP was \$96,100 well more than the cost of the four mailers produced by the ARP in coordination with the Murkowski campaign.
- 11) As can be seen from the attached exhibits, the disbursements by the party occurred after the cutoff date for the pre-general election report. These expenses will be included on the post general election report which we are currently compiling and expect to file in a timely fashion.

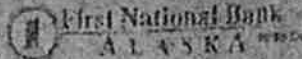
