	On April 25, 2019, the Commission made reason-to-believe findings in this matter and approved the Factual and Legal Analysis as last circulated by the Office of General Counsel on April 24, 2019 at 4:16 p.m. and as amended at the table.  It has come to our attention that Sen. Paul did not join his authorized committee and his leadership PAC in retaining counsel, and thus we have concluded that it would be appropriate to send him a separate Factual and Legal Analysis. Attached for the Commission's approval on an expedited 48-hour tally are separate Factual and Legal Analyses — one for the authorized committee and leadership PAC, and the other for Sen.
