18 **SUBJECT:** MUR 7191 (Freedom for All Americans) Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation

21 On April 25, 2019, the Commission found reason to believe that Freedom for All
22 Americans and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee"), violated
23 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.9(e)(3) by failing to timely remedy general election
24 contributions.¹ On April 8, 2021, the Commission authorized the Office of the General Counsel
25 to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.²
