Dear Mr. Sanderson:

On November 14, 2016, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Reinventing a New Direction Political Action Committee and Kevin Broghamer as treasurer ("RAND PAC"), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On April 8, 2021, the Commission voted to: dismiss the allegations that RAND PAC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(a)(2)(A) by making excessive in-kind contributions during the pre-candidacy period under 11 C.F.R. § 110.2(1); dismiss the allegations that RAND PAC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(a)(2)(A) by making excessive in-kind contributions in the form of payments for testing-the-waters expenses; and dismiss the allegations that RAND PAC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) by failing to report making in-kind contributions. Accordingly, on June 25, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter.
