MUR 7200 (Joni for Iowa) Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation and Case Closing

Memorandum

On November 15, 2016, the Commission found reason to believe that Joni for Iowa and Cabell Hobbs in his official capacity as treasurer ("Committee" or "Respondent") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30104(b)(8), 30116(f), and 30118 by failing to accurately disclose debts and by knowingly accepting and failing to refund excessive and prohibited contributions. The Commission also authorized pre-probable cause conciliation with the Respondent and approved a conciliation agreement. We are attaching a negotiated conciliation agreement that has been signed by counsel of the Respondent. We recommend that the Commission accept the negotiated agreement and close the file in this matter.
