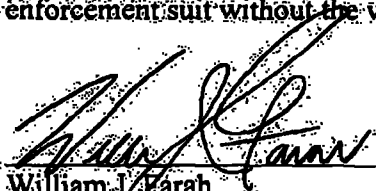

CONSENT TO EXTEND TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's ("Commission") agreement to allow James Laurita (hereinafter "Respondent") time to supplement his sua sponte submission, Respondent consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6) for an additional period of 120 days. Respondent therefore agrees that the time for the Commission to institute a civil enforcement action in connection with Pre-MUR 567 is hereby extended by an additional period of 120 days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statutes of limitations or repose that may be applicable. This Consent supplements the Consent previously agreed to by Respondents on April 17, 2014.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
