**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW
ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING**

Respondent Nicola Bulgari hereby consents as follows in connection with MUR 7226, pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6):

1. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2462, the Federal Election Commission (FEC) is required to commence any "action, suit or proceeding for the enforcement of any civil fine penalty, or forfeitures, pecuniary or otherwise," against Respondent within five years from the date that the claim first accrued.
2. Respondent agrees that the statute of limitations codified at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 shall be tolled from the Effective Date of this consent for forty-five (45) calendar days ("Tolling Period").
3. This consent shall not affect any applicable statute of limitations or time-related arguments, defenses, or affirmative claims that would have been available to Respondent as of the Effective Date of the Tolling Period.
4. Nothing in this consent shall be construed as an admission by Respondent regarding the merits of any possible claim, proceeding, or action by the FEC.
5. The Effective Date of this consent shall be the date upon which it is executed on behalf of Respondent.
