On March 31, 2017, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") found reason to believe that your client, Michael Fleck, knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(b)(3) and 30114(b), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. The Commission then instituted an investigation into this matter. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on March 25, 2021, to take no further action and closed the file.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
