Dear Mr. Keane:

The Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") previously notified your client, Nicola Bulgari, that it had ascertained information in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities indicating that your client may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), by accepting excessive or prohibited in-kind contributions. We received a response to this notification.

After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission, on March 25, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegations that your client made prohibited foreign national contributions, in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30121, and closed the file.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
