1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Duncan D. Hunter, Margret Hunter, and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer, knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b).
 - b. Find reason to believe that Duncan D. Hunter for Congress and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer, knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(6)(a).
 - c. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with Duncan D. Hunter, Margaret Hunter, and Duncan D. Hunter for Congress and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - d. Approve the appropriate letters.
 - e. Approve the proposed conciliation agreement, subject to revising it to include the Commission's knowing and willful findings in the first paragraph.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioner Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.
