



**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME  
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting a 30-day extension to respond to the Reason to Believe notification letter in this matter, Respondents Duncan D. Hunter for Congress and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer hereby consent to extend the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement suit that the Commission might institute pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for an additional period of thirty (30) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondents.
