Recommendation to Revise Conciliation Agreement to Include Regional Medical

Centers – 48 Hour Tally

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On May 9, 2017, the Commission voted to find reason to believe that Cancer Treatment Centers of America Global, Inc. ("CTCA"), Eastern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Midwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Southwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Southwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., and Western Regional Medical Center, Inc. (together, the "Regional Medical Centers"), violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) and 30122. On the recommendation of the Office of the General Counsel ("OGC"), the Commission also voted to enter into conciliation and approve the proposed Conciliation Agreement with respect to CTCA, Stephen Bonner, Robert Mayo, and Richard Stephenson.

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33 34 OGC's recommendations in the First General Counsel's Report regarding conciliation² inadvertently omitted the Regional Medical Centers.³ We would like to correct this omission by recommending that the Commission revise the prior authorization of conciliation and the previously authorized Conciliation Agreement to include the Regional Medical Centers. have attached a markup of the Conciliation Agreement that was approved by the Commission on May 9, 2017, which includes the Regional Medical Centers.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Revise the prior authorization of conciliation to include the following additional respondents: Eastern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Midwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Southeastern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Southwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., and Western Regional Medical Center, Inc.
- 2. Revise the previously approved Conciliation Agreement to include the following additional respondents: Eastern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Midwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Southwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., Southwestern Regional Medical Center, Inc., and Western Regional Medical Center, Inc.
