The Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated May 19, 2017, but there were insufficient votes to either dismiss or find no reason to believe that the respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, on September 14, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
