17	SUBJECT:	MUR 7257 (TeaPartyExpress.org) - Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation Agreement

On June 21, 2017, the Commission found reason to believe that TeaPartyExpress.org and Kelly Lawler in her official capacity as treasurer ("the Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30104(b)(4)(H)(iii), (b)(8), and (g) by failing to file 24-Hour and 48-Hour Reports of · 21 independent expenditures and failing to itemize debts and obligations.<sup>1</sup> The Commission authorized pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement Attached is a negotiated conciliation agreement that has been signed by counsel to the Committee. Attach. 1. We recommend that the Commission accept this agreement and close the file in this matter.
