On July 14, 2017, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by your clients, the Commission, on June 4, 2019, voted to dismiss this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
