## SUBJECT: MUR 7275 (Conservative Campaign Committee) - Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation Agreement

On September 12, 2017, the Commission found reason to believe that Conservative Campaign Committee and Kelly Lawler in her official capacity as treasurer ("the Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § $30104(\mathrm{~b})(4)(\mathrm{H})(\mathrm{iii})$ and (g) by failing to properly disclose independent expenditures totaling $\$ 270,210$; failing to file 24 -Hour Reports of independent expenditures totaling $\$ 12,302$; and failing to file any reports for independent expenditures totaling $\$ 3,774$. ${ }^{1}$ The Commission authorized pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement

Attached is a negotiated conciliation agreement that has been signed by counsel to the Committee. Attach. 1. We recommend that the Commission accept this agreement and close the file in this matter.
