

individuals and PACs. As such, it should be off-limits to State Rep. Ryan Mackenzie while he is a federal candidate.

Second, State Rep. Mackenzie's state campaign account now has made an in-kind contribution to his federal congressional campaign. If the value of goods and services the state campaign paid for in connection with the federal campaign kick-off event (and any other in-kind contributions it has made to date) exceeds \$1,000, then federal law requires Rep. Mackenzie's state campaign to register with the FEC as a federal political committee, report information about its receipts and disbursements, and abide by federal amount limitations and source prohibitions in its fundraising.

Find that State Rep. Ryan Edward Mackenzie illegally spent funds that were raised by his state campaign account in excess of the federal limits on contributions from individuals, in violation of the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act's soft money ban, and order his state campaign to register as a federal PAC, file FEC reports as required by law, and abide by federal amount limitations and source prohibitions in all its future fundraising. And lastly to investigate the full extent of Rep. Ryan Mackenzie's use of state campaign funds to unlawfully subsidize his campaign for Congress.
