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legal basis for the recommendation. Respondent filed a response to the General Counsel's brief
 on January 7, 2020 ("Response").<sup>3</sup>

Pursuant to the Agency Procedure Following the Submission of Probable Cause Briefs
by the Office of General Counsel, 76 Fed. Reg. 63,570 (Oct. 13, 2011), OGC is notifying the
Commission that it intends to proceed with the recommendation to find probable cause to believe
that Respondents violated the Federal Election Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act") based on
the factual and legal analysis set forth in the General Counsel's Brief. A copy of this Notice is
being provided to Respondent at the same time that it is circulated to the Commission.

For the reasons set forth in the General Counsel's Brief, the Commission can and should proceed with finding probable cause to believe that CTR misreported the purpose of a portion of the \$400,000 transfer made to AB PAC in December 2015.
