AB PAC/Correct the Record

Dear Mr. Svoboda:

On October 12, 2017, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, AB PAC and Rodell Mollineau in his official capacity as treasurer (f/k/a American Bridge 21st Century and Rodell Mollineau in his official capacity as treasurer) ("AB PAC"), and Correct the Record and Elizabeth Cohen in her official capacity as treasurer ("Correct the Record") of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

After reviewing the allegations contained in the Complaint and, information provided by you, the Commission, on March 19, 2019, found reason to believe that AB PAC and Correct the Record violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) of the Act, and instituted an investigation. Copies of the Factual and Legal Analyses, explaining the basis for the Commission's findings, were provided at that time.

On March 11, 2021, the Commission considered the General Counsel's Brief and Reply Brief and voted to dismiss the matter and close the file. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
