Dear Mr. Woodhouse:

This letter will follow up on our October 19, 2017 letter to you, which acknowledged receipt of MUR 7287, a complaint filed by you on behalf of the American Democracy Legal Fund ("ADLF"). Upon further review, we have determined that the notarization on the complaint is defective, in that the notary failed to include the date on which you subscribed and swore to the complaint. See D.C. Code § 42–147(a) (2017) ("A notarial act shall be evidenced by a certificate signed and dated by a notarial officer") (emphasis added).

If you wish to proceed with MUR 7827, please provide us with a corrected complaint no later than Wednesday, November 22, 2017. Otherwise, we will not be able to continue processing this matter.
