Dear Mr. Legare:

On October 19, 2017, your clients were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time you were given a copy of the complaint and informed that a response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.

On November 24, 2017, the Commission received a corrected complaint with a properly executed jurat, which sets forth the date the original complaint was notarized and sworn. We also received a brief statement from the notary herself.

Enclosed is a copy of corrected complaint. As such this submission is considered an amendment to the original complaint, you are hereby afforded an additional 15 days in which to respond to the allegations. If we do not hear further form you, we will proceed with the response you previously provided.
