Dear Mr. Weiss:

We write as counsel to Hillary for America and Elizabeth Jones in her official capacity as treasurer ("Respondent"), regarding the above-referenced matter. Respondent received the General Counsel's Brief on November 19, 2021, meaning the response is due on December 6, 2021. Respondent respectfully requests that the response time be extended by 15 days.

This extension is warranted because the timing of the General Counsel's Brief gives Respondent an inadequate opportunity to prepare a response. Respondent received the brief at the end of the work day on Friday, November 19, 2021. There is a dearth of working days in the 15-day period following the Respondent's receipt of the General Counsel Brief due to the Thanksgiving holiday and three intervening weekends. Extending the response deadline by 15 days would give the Respondent a fair and reasonable opportunity to respond to the arguments in the General Counsel's Brief.
