Campaign Legal Center/Catherine Kinckley Kelley v. Zinke for Congress

Dear Federal Election Commission,

Please accept this letter as proof that no action should be taken against myself, F. Edward Buttrey, with regards to the above matter, MUR 7293. The letter from the FEC and attached complaint were received at my offices at 708 Central Avenue on Friday, 17 November 2017. This response is being sent via email on 21 November 2017, well within the 15-day window that is stated in the letter from the FEC.

This letter will address the following sections of the complaint, MUR 7293, that deal with my purchase of a 2004 Kountry Star M-3706 motorhome from the Zinke for Congress campaign on 5 June 2017 for a purchase price of \$25,000.00. (See attachment A – Check 5033 from F. Edward Buttrey to Zinke for Congress).

Section 2: This section states that a motorhome was sold to a “family friend at a below market price”. I dispute the fact that the motorhome was sold to me at “below market price” as the recreational vehicle was in marginal shape, with engine problems, system wide problems, and a custom wrap for the Zinke for Congress campaign that needed to be removed and replaced. Upon taking possession of the motorhome, engine problems were immediately experienced, and the motorhome was taken to a local diesel engine repair shop, Mechanix Unlimited, for repairs (see attachment B – Mechanix Unlimited Invoice). After engine repairs were completed, the motorhome was taken to Gardner’s RV & Trailer for system maintenance and appraisal. See attachment C – Appraisal from Gardner’s RV & Trailer for professional evaluation of the value of the motorhome, post engine repair. The appraised value as of the date of delivery to the RV dealership (26 June 2017) was seen to be \$24,000.00.

Section 19: This section states that the “NADA Guides, an online valuation services, listed the average price of the RV at the time of sale as \$49,300, with the low valuation at \$40,900”. See attachment D - NADA Guides Valuation that shows the Used Wholesale Trade-In value at \$34,500 and the Used Retail value at \$48,450.

Section 43: This section states that “In June 2017, Zinke for Congress sold the RV for \$25,000 to an “old friend” of Zinke, Ed Buttrey - \$34,100 less than, or 42 percent of, what it had bought it for the previous year. At the time of the sale, valuation guides estimated the value of the RV at \$49,300”. I did in fact pay the amount of \$25,000 to the Zinke for Congress campaign for the motorhome. The average “Used Retail” value of the motorhome, as seen in the NADA Guides, for a motorhome with working engine, working systems and non-custom wrap is stated as \$48,450. The motorhome upon purchase, and after engine repairs, was appraised by a professional RV dealership at a value of \$24,000.

In addition to the engine issues that required repair, the motorhome had other serious issues such as non-functioning power awning that was damaged in some type of collision, rear broken closet doors (mechanism broken and glass broken), non-functioning power levelling system, non-working refrigerator and icebox, broken rear window closure mechanism, window leaks, non-fully functioning slideouts (2), missing main console television, non-working bedroom television, non-working stereo system, blown speakers throughout, electrical power drain, missing TV cabinet enclosure, missing/broken marker lights, non-functioning tail light, rear roof ladder damage, power supply panel damage, missing main air conditioner cover and damage to air conditioner unit, cracked windshield, broken refrigerator grill, non-functioning external storage door locks, bent exhaust pipe, inoperable bathroom vent cover and motor, damaged rear brush/exhaust guard, rough running generator needing maintenance, and other issues. In addition, the cost estimated by Gardner's RV & Trailer to remove the custom wrap is \$2,380 (20 hours at \$119/hour) and by Kelly Signs to design and install a new wrap at \$8,000.00. To move the motorhome between repair shops, a charge of \$518.08 was paid to Fast Signs to temporarily cover any wrapping that stated Zinke or Congress on the RV. These issues contribute to the appraised value of \$24,000, after completion of engine maintenance, that was stated by the professional RV dealership. It is my assertion that the fair market value of the motorhome, as purchased by myself from the Zinke for Congress campaign was certainly not in excess of the \$25,000 that was paid. (See attachment B – Mechanix Unlimited Invoice, attachment C – Appraisal from Gardner's RV & Trailer, attachment D - NADA Guides Valuation, attachment E – Gardner's RV & Trailer Repair Invoice, attachment F – Reference Audio Video Repair Invoice).

Section 44: This section states that "..... or it sold the RV to Zinke's friend Buttrey at a price below fair market value". The marginal shape of the RV upon purchase, as further proven by the value seen in the appraisal provided by the RV dealership, proves that the price paid for the motorhome was at or more than the fair market value of the RV at the time of purchase.


Section 46: This section states "If Zinke for Congress sold the RV to Ed Buttrey at a price below fair market value, the difference between that value and the purchase price would constitute the conversion of campaign funds to the personal use of Buttrey, 11 C.F.R 113.1 (g)(3), in violation of 52 U.S.C. 30114(b)(1). As the purchase price of the motorhome paid to the Zinke for Congress campaign was at or more than the fair market value, it must follow that there was no illegal or inappropriate conversion of campaign funds for my personal use.

To summarize, I believe that the appraisal of the motorhome shows the true value of the RV when purchased from the Zinke for Congress campaign, and does not even consider the deduction of cost for the needed engine repairs. To date, I have expended \$30,450 for the motorhome in purchase price and repairs. I expect to expend an additional minimum \$17,000 to bring the motorhome up to average retail standard, which includes removal and replacement of the custom wrap (currently wrapped in campaign design), replacement of the power awning, replacing the closet doors, replacement of the rear window closure, fixing main window leaks, new windshield, new exhaust pipe, new vents/motors, new debris guard, new refrigerator grill, new compartment locks, and fixing other miscellaneous items. Once all these additional repairs are completed, I believe that the motorhome value will indeed approach the Used Retail Value as listed in the NADA Guides.

To whom it may concern,

I have been employed at Gardner's RV for 19 years, with the last 5 years as Store and Sales Manager. I am in charge of purchasing new and used inventory and oversee reconditioning of used inventory as well.

I have reviewed the NADA book value provided by Trevor Rebish for the 2004 Newmar Kountry Star RV in or around April 2016. Trevor was a Salesman at Gardner's at that time. In 2016 Trevor provided the NADA book value of \$59,100. Book Values are produced when we get requests from banks and insurance companies to establish retail value of a specific year and model of an RV.

In the spring of 2017 I evaluated this unit for Ryan Zinke and looked it up in the NADA book, took in consideration reconditioning and repairs and quoted a value of \$25,000 to \$30,000.

The obvious repairs the motorhome needs are as follows;

Remove vinyl wrap, which would certainly peel paint underneath given the number of years it has been on there. The estimate to remove wrap and address body work and paint was valued at \$15,000 to \$20,000.

The motorhome had mechanical issues that would take over \$1,000 to fix. Interior would have needed carpet and some upholstery replaced and cosmetic attention costing \$3,000 to \$4,000.

I have also reviewed Craig Painter's evaluation of the RV from around June 2017 and I feel that it was accurate and reasonable.
