**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") granting you an extension until August 15, 2019, to respond to the Commission's Request for Written Answers and Production of Documents received by you on June 25, 2019, Respondent Mark Takai for Congress and Dylan Beesley in his official capacity as treasurer hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7310 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 21 days.

This agreement will extend the time for the Commission to institute a civil law enforcement suit in connection with MUR 7310 under 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 21 calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
