**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME  
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for an extension of the period in which to engage with the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") in pre-probable cause conciliation by 30 days from January 21, 2022, Respondent Mark Takai for Congress and Dylan Beesley in his official capacity as treasurer ("Respondent") hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7310 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 30 days.

This agreement extends the time for the Commission to institute a civil law enforcement suit in connection with MUR 7310 under 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 30 days from the expiration of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter. This extension is in addition to the tolling of the statute of limitations in MUR 7310 agreed to by Respondent on July 25, 2019.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
