RE: Proposed Probable Cause Conciliation Agreement

Attached is a proposed agreement for probable cause conciliation with Mark Takai for Congress and Dylan Beesley in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee"), Dylan Beesley, and Lanakila Strategies, LLC ("Lanakila"). The proposed agreement is for the Commission's consideration along with the Office of General Counsel's Notices to the Commission Following the Submission of Probable Cause Briefs ("OGC Notices"), which are being submitted to the Commission simultaneously with this Memorandum. The OGC Notices inform the Commission that this Office intends to proceed with the recommendation that the Commission find probable cause to believe that the Committee, Beesley, and Lanakila violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting campaign funds to personal use in connection with certain payments the Committee made to Beesley and Lanakila in 2017.
