Dear Mr. Epstein:

The Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated August 14, 2019, that were administratively severed into matter under review (“MUR”) 7313. *See* Letter to Allen J. Epstein from Kathryn Ross, FEC re: MUR 7637 (Sept. 24, 2020). There were an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that the respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). Accordingly, on March 23, 2021, the Commission closed the file in MUR 7313. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission’s decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
