On January 31, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging that you violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On July 9, 2019, the Commission considered the matter but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a) by directly or indirectly making foreign national contributions, donations, or expenditures. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
